Speech: Frankie, Jakub, Nicole, Suzie, Laura and Robert

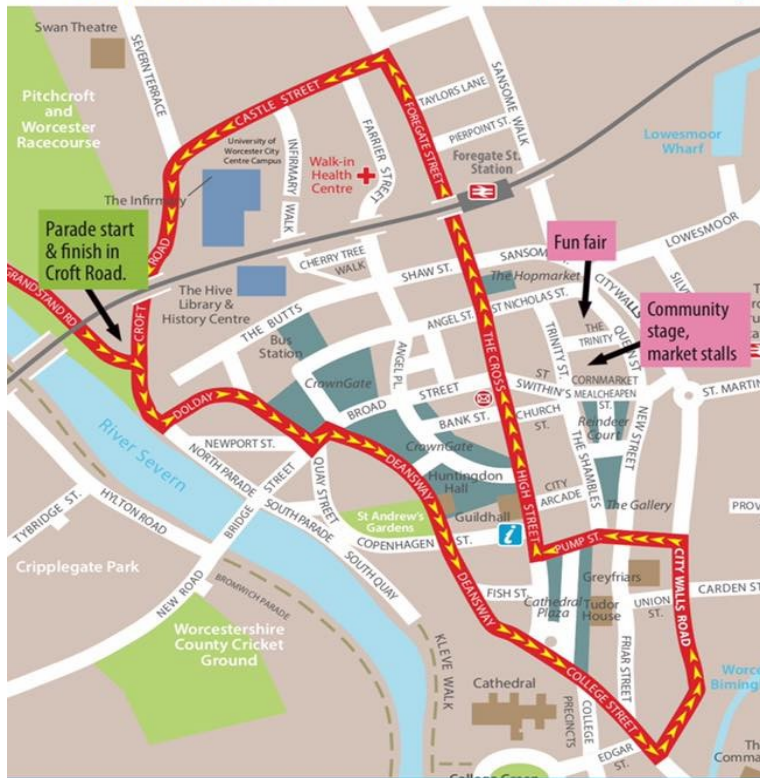
All the children spoke confidently and the judges were very impressed with their skills.
