



## Hot Weather

Please do not send children to school with energy, fizzy or high sugar drinks. Drinks of water are available in all classrooms.

## Early Bird's Breakfast Club

Early Birds is open every term day from 8.00—8.40am. All from Reception to Year 6 are invited (Nursery parents should speak to Nursery staff) at a charge of 30p a session. Places do not need to be booked in advanced. The sessions are fully supervised and lots of activities are available for children of all ages. Children can choose from a range of cereals, toast, jam, juice, milkshakes and warm drinks (warm drinks for Y3—6 only for safety). The last admittance time for breakfast club is 8,30am. *Please be aware that if children do not go to breakfast club, there is no supervision on the playground until 8.40am, therefore, unsupervised children should not be on school grounds until that time.*
