



Medication

We would like to remind you of our policy for giving medication at school.

Any children who need long-term medication (e.g. inhalers) administered or kept at school, need a health care plan completed. Parents should meet with Mrs McGorman (our head First Aider) to do this. These plans are reviewed annually, but please keep school up to date with any changes, as soon as they occur.

For children on short term prescribed medication, such as antibiotics, a form must be completed by a parent in order for a member of school staff to give the medicine. Ideally medicines should be brought into school in their original packaging, which has the child's name on it. You will be asked to give specific instructions on dosage of medicine and timings.

Please do not send children into school with any kind of medicine, without informing members of staff and completing this paperwork.

Generally staff don't give non-prescribed medications, such as Calpol.
