Christingle

All KS2 children should have returned their slips about attending Christingle on **Monday 3rd December**. If you haven't done so, please return by 9am on Monday morning.

We hope as many children as possible will join us in this special celebration.

A reminder that children will go home at 3pm as normal and should return to school at 5pm. The service will start at 6pm. Parents are invited, but there are limited spaces, so please ask if you have not received tickets. There is no charge. Hot drinks and cake will be available for parents who want to wait in school between 5 and 6pm. A collection will be made at the end of the service for The Christingle Society. Children need to be collected at 7pm.

Nursery Christmas Sing-a-long

Nursery parents are invited to join their children in Christmas songs on **Monday 17th December**. There will be two performances—10.30am for morning children; 2pm for afternoon children. Parents of children who stay all day can choose which service to attend. Children should wear their nursery uniform and costumes will be provided by staff.

Children who do not usually attend nursery on a Monday, are invited to join their friends, however will only be able to be in school during the performance and then go home.

Parents do not need tickets but please could you limit attendance to 3 adults per child.

All children from Reception to Year 6 will be provided with a Christmas dinner on Friday 21st December. You do not need to complete a menu for this (catering staff know children's dietary requirements). The meal is provided by the school and there is no charge. No packed lunches please. Nursery full-time children will have packed lunches as normal.

A letter is being sent home with this newsletter for each family to complete. Main school will shut for pupils at **1pm on Tuesday 18th December**.

We request as many children as possible are collected by a family member so that you can enjoy the school fayre together. No child will be able to leave school before 3pm without a named adult (over 18) collecting him/ her.

Nursery and Tots will remain open during the Fayre but school staff will ask parents individually if you intend to send your child that afternoon or not.
