


Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

What is the multiplication check?

At the end of Year 4, schools are required to administer multiplication tables check to Year 4 children. The check tests whether children have a good knowledge of all times tables up to 12×12 . Schools are given a 'testing window' of when to administer the test to each child; this year, it is within the first 3 weeks after the May half-term holiday

What will my child be asked to do?



The times table check is an online test consisting of 25 questions. Children have up to 6 seconds to answer each question. Each child only has one chance to sit the test, although they have the opportunity to practice in the weeks leading up to June.

When will I find out about how my child has done?

There is no pass mark for the test. You will be informed of your child's score as part of their end of year report.

It may not be appropriate for all children to take part in the test. Your child's class teacher will discuss this with you.
