



Worms and Wellies, Session 2, was all about learning why soil and mud is important to our environment and why we need it. We learnt that without soil there would be no plants and food and we discussed how to avoid contaminating soil by recycling certain things, like batteries, in special recycling bins. We shared our knowledge of different unique recycling centres over our local area to help our group become better at recycling. We then mixed soil and mud with PVA glue and water to make mud paint and we made our own homemade paint brushes out of twigs, sticks, and leaves to create some mud pictures using recycled newspapers. The open-ended nature of painting with mud and soil encouraged creative thinking and allowed our children to create freely without fear of mistake with us in this fun and messy session.
